Scripture For The Month; Lectionary For Sunday

12 th August. Ephesians 4:25-5:2 J.B. Phillips New Testament
25 Finish, then, with lying and tell your neighbour the truth. For we are not separate units but intimately related to each other in Christ. 26-27 If you are angry, be sure that it is not out of wounded pride or bad temper. Never go to bed angry—don't give the devil that sort of foothold. The new life means positive good 28 If you used to be a thief you must not only give up stealing, but you must learn to make an honest living, so that you may be able to give to those in need. 29 Let there be no more foul language, but good words instead—words suitable for the occasion, which God can use to help other people. 30 Never hurt the Holy Spirit. He is, remember, the personal pledge of your eventual full redemption. 31-32 Let there be no more resentment, no more anger or temper, no more violent self-assertiveness, no more slander and no more malicious remarks, Be kind to each other, be understanding. Be as ready to forgive others as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you. 5 1-2 As children copy their fathers you, as God's children, are to copy him. Live your lives in love—the same sort of love which Christ gives us and which he perfectly expressed when he gave himself up for us in sacrifice to God.
